Dear family,

I used to work at a place where all employees were sent notes on their dress for special occasions: "be sure to wear your best red outfits, a reminder that Friday we should all have a violet accessory, and don't forget that Wednesday we are expected to wear blue tops." I thought it was ridiculous, personally, but it seemed a fun little tradition to keep people engaged and was meant to be a symbol of unity, until it did quite the opposite. At first it started with little jokes and poking fun when a co-worker or guest would show up not dressed as the memo stated. Progressively the discrimination got out of hand to where communication broke down and people were intentionally excluded. So what's up with the king (who represents God) in today's Gospel. He seems to contradict His own generosity when after inviting all sorts of people, regardless of their reputation, He decided to eject a guest who is found not wearing the "wedding garment." A closer reading of the passage shows us that the issue was not garment at all, but his silence when the king inquired in a friendly manner as to why he was not dressed properly. This, in Jesus day, would have been seen as a sign of grave disrespect. The issue here is not external credentials, after all, all people that were found wandering the streets were invited to the banquet without background checks or any criterion considered other than the fact that they were found. In the end, the man was rejected not because of clothes, but because he did not consider it important to respond the king's concern and thus excluded himself from the banquet, from the communion which all invited people were sharing. We are all invited into relationship with God and to share His joy, no one is excluded. However, invitation in itself does not secure a place with God, but our desire to actively live His joy and to work at that relationship. While God always remains generous and loving, He will not force us to love Him in return.

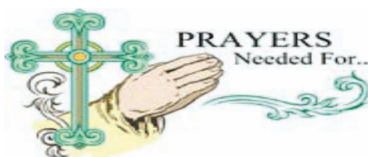
