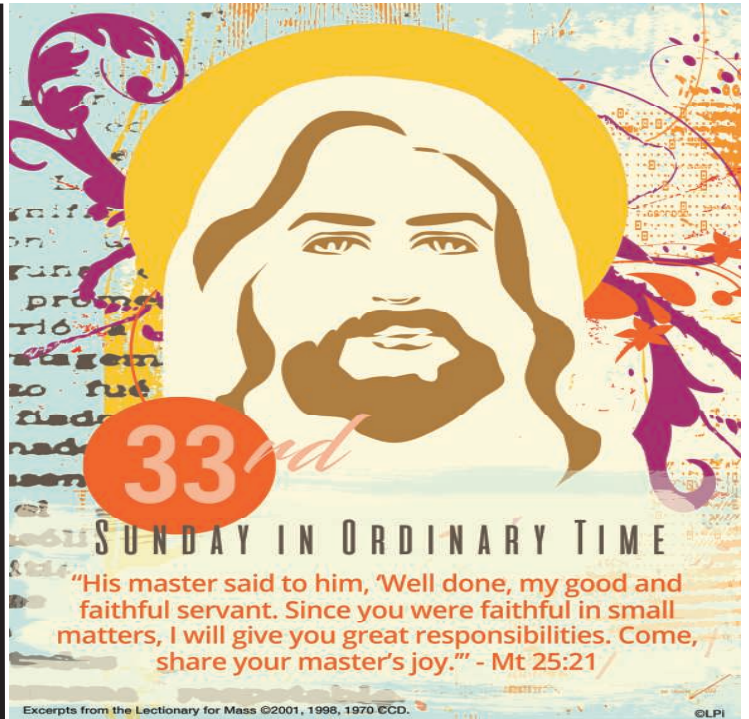

Dear family,

There are many who are impressed with Pope Francis, as they should be. However, I have to admit that it is a pet peeve of mine when many think he is inciting change, when really his language reflects that of Our Lord from over two thousand years ago. For example, Pope Francis has been quoted as saying the Church is "field hospital" and that we must "go out to the peripheries" to seek out and include the marginalized. All of these are such beautiful images that give those who minister and those who are seeking hope great consolation. But, dear friends, this idea is nothing new. Consider today's Gospel: Jesus uses a parable to describe the kingdom of God and how we need to use our gifts and multiply them. Two of the three servants are regarded for making more profit from what they have been given. The third servant, taking a more conservative bent, decides to hide what he was given for fear that the master's ways were too risky. He wanted to preserve and maintain, not bad intentions, but detrimental when opportunities for real growth to occur. Jesus encourages all of us to use our "talents" and multiply them. We are indeed called to "go out" and put our gifts at the service of the Church and the world, because then our light can shine. Fear causes people to hide and turn in on themselves, faith and hope causes one to shine brightly, let us seek to shine brightly with what we have been given. In His Joy, Father Daniel
