He graduated from that institution in 2016. On May 21, 2016 Fr. Angelo was ordained to the priesthood with 4 other men for the Archdiocese of Santa Fe. From that time until now, he has been assigned as an associate pastor for the parish of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Clovis. He has, of course, visited Taos in the past as a seminarian, but is very excited to be with us for our upcoming mission during the first week of Advent.


