Dear family,

Now entering this second week of Advent at what seems like lightspeed, we hear the beginning of the Gospel of Mark. Immediately after stating that this is the "Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ" being proclaimed, that God is doing something new, Mark quotes Isaiah the prophet of an ancient prophecy. John the Baptist has a particular vocation. He is to "make strait the paths of the Lord." By quoting Isaiah, Mark is saying that God has been on this same mission through the prophets and every person He has chosen. But this Ancient God is asking us to make His paths straight to our hearts, here and now in 2017 A.D.

Last Sunday we began Advent by taking a step back from all of our cares and recognized that watching for the Lord's coming is most important. We recognized our hunger and need for Christ, Who is our peace and fulfillment. Now recognizing that need, Mother Church is telling us in the readings that we need to do some "winter cleaning" and make sure we are ready. It's profound to realize how much we need God, but then we also must realize how much we allow to get in the way of His coming. From sin to our expectations, we need to clear the path such that God can embrace us in all His fullness. As we move forward on this Advent journey, let us amend our lives to "make strait His paths!"
