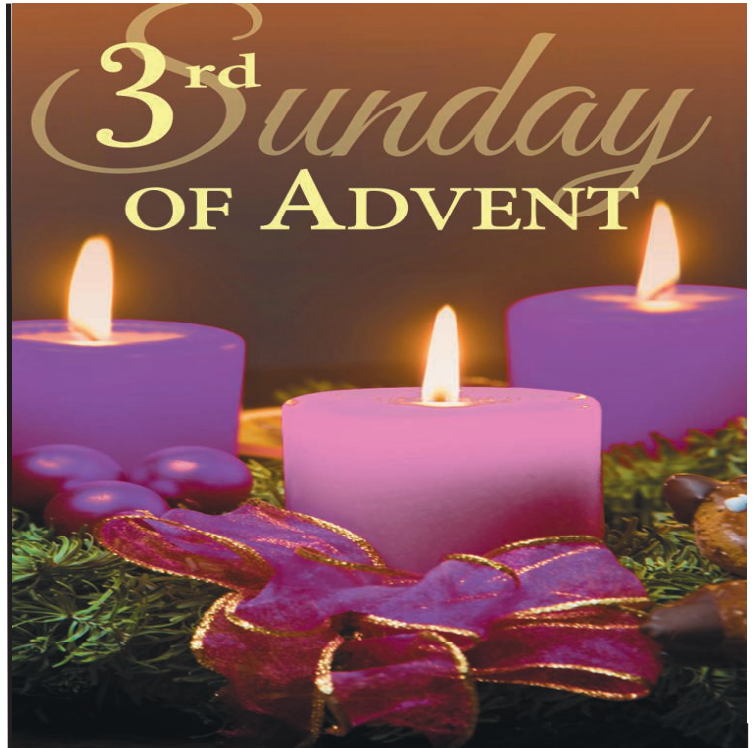

Can one Mass “count” for both the 4th Sunday of Advent and Christmas? Have no fear, the Church has prepared for this. Consider the following statement, “*The primary purpose of a holyday of obligation is to call the faithful to celebrate particular dimensions of the mysteries of Christ and His Church. Since obligation is attached to specific mysteries being celebrated, it is not possible to fulfil two obligations in one celebration.*” Since then we are called to celebrate both the 4th Sunday of Advent and Christmas, there are four ways one can plan to honor both. Please plan which of the following options you will choose this year:

Option 1: Sunday Morning + Christmas Morning

Option 2: Sunday Morning + Sunday Evening Vigil

Option 3: Saturday Evening + Sunday Evening Vigil

Option 4: Saturday Evening + Christmas Morning

Dear family,

Happy Gaudete Sunday! Today the liturgical color changes slightly from violet to rose, to remind us that we are called to “rejoice” in this preparation time. After all, are we not preparing for something joyous, the completion of our joy to come into the world? Today we light the rose colored candle and are made aware that only two weeks remain until Christmas. Our first Sunday in Advent we recognized that the ultimate thing we want and need is Christ. Last Sunday we discussed how recognizing that hunger for Christ Himself, we need to “make straight the paths of the Lord” in our life. We are called during advent to do a little cleaning and remove anything that prohibits us from receiving God and His message. Today we realized that the most important piece of our spiritual attics that we have to remove is our pride. If we are going to receive the living God, we need to persevere in humility so that our egos do not get in the way of God’s Word. After all, if we are too full of ourselves, then how can we have room for God? John the Baptists, one of the ideal disciples of Christ, teaches us through his example today. When asked by the Jewish religious leaders what John has to say for himself, he says nothing about himself, only about God. “I am the voice of one crying out in the desert, make straight the way of the Lord” This is the same John who will later recognize, “He must increase and I must decrease.” What humility, especially from someone who was so popular! Let us pray for the strength to resist our egos and “decrease” and Christ seeks to increase in our lives.
