Father's Housekeeping

One of the greatest honors we receive as Catholics is being chosen to sponsor a child for their baptism and/or confirmation. These are sacraments of initiation and therefore pivotal to the formation of a person who is beginning his faith journey. So it is important that his sponsors or *padrinos* be able to accompany them. The Church makes it clear that sponsors are taking on a huge responsibility long after the reception cake is eaten. They must see to it, that the child is raised with the faith and must be an example who encourages the child to live their faith fully and faithfully. According to the norms for our Archdiocese, a sponsor must:

- be sixteen years of age
 - Be fully initiated into the Church (i.e. baptized & confirmed)
 - Have received first holy communion
 - Regularly going to Mass and receiving the Sacrament of Penance once a year
 - Not be cohabitating or be married outside the Church
- Let us be aware of what our Church is asking of us.

"Quiet, come out!"

Dear family,

There are certain aspects of our faith that are sometimes mistakenly considered "mysterious." Please do not misunderstand me, the fact of that matter is that whenever we are dealing with the things of heaven, the things of God, then there will always be a mysterious factor that we will never fully comprehend. However, insofar as my job to make the Gospel real, tangible, and practical to you, then there are some subjects that I must demystify for you. One of these such subject is evil. One common remark of saintly folk over the years is that people make two common mistakes when it comes to evil. The first is that they deny its existence. I honestly hope none of us struggles with this tenant of faith, because aside from Hollywood horror plots, the fact of that matter is that evil exists. We do not need to ask an exorcist for his stories when we see such greed, lust, and indifference in the world. The other mistake is that people give evil too much credit, that is that we obsess, often in fear, over what the evil one can do to us. We can then rightly understand Jesus actions today as a model for how we deal with the evil in our lives. Jesus gives no room for the demon to speak. He simply says, "Quiet, come out of him!" He makes a brief and authoritative command. He speaks as one with authority and confidence. While none of us should go looking to pick a fight with a demon, we nevertheless in our struggle with doubt, temptation, and fear should act like Our Lord. Firstly, we should not entertain too much when it comes to an evil word or idea, it's usually a lie anyway. Secondly, we have authority too, through Him. We are sons and daughters, we have been grafted on to Christ, we have the trinity dwelling within us, and we are the beloved of God. If we take God's actions seriously in our lives through the sacraments and in our personal relationship with him, then we need to call those to mind. God is with us to stay, let that be the reality that steals our breath and inspires us to be strong in the face of evil, an evil that our God has conquered!
