pastor's Corner

Dear family,

We find ourselves at the beginning of another Lent, a sacred time. Many use this time to rediscover their faith and deepen their prayer lives. I feel we sometimes use lent as the time to get spiritual oil changes and wheel alignments. Perhaps, we are looking at this all wrong. While Lent is a time to slow down and smell the roses, it is not the case that we need to acquire anything. Whether we feel like we have drifted a bit in our relationship with God or whether we feel completely lost and have no clue where to begin to mend this bond, I have good news: you don't have to earn back points or climb a ladder. The second reading today reminds us that we have already received a powerful promise and presence in the sacrament of baptism. In some sense, God is already within us and our job is to search for Him and grasp for Him, but to allow Him to shine through us. On the day we were baptized, the flame of faith was lit within us. The truth is that our flame is still burning deep within, we have only to flame it into a strong fire. And how do we do this? With the tools the Church gives us: prayer, fasting, almsgiving. We fan this flame by drawing close to Christ in the sacraments, especially confessions and communion. Our job is not to become better people, but a people transformed by God who has already touched us, called us by name, and who sends us to spread the Good News of His love. Happy Lent to you and your family!
