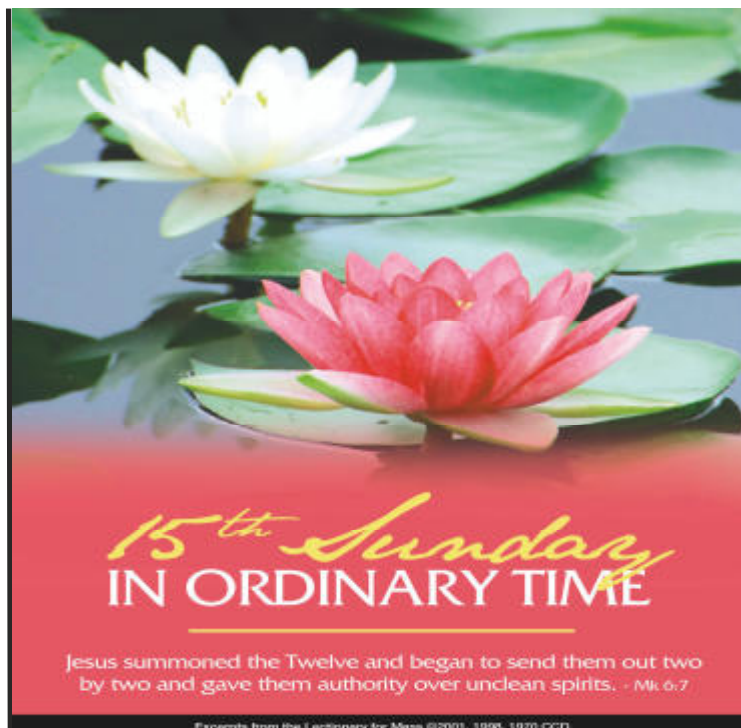

Pastor's Corner

Dear family,

I am often asked, especially by young people, why I became a priest. Maybe some of you would like to ask the same question. Let me briefly try to reply. I must begin by saying that it is impossible to explain entirely. For it remains a mystery, even to myself. How does one explain the ways of God? Yet, I know that, at a certain point in my life, I became convinced that Christ was saying to me what he had said to thousands before me: "Come, follow me!" There was a clear sense that what I heard in my heart was no human voice, nor was it just an idea of my own. Christ was calling me to serve him as a priest." Saint John Paul II wrote these words over forty years ago during his apostolic visit to the United States and it sends chills down my spine that in a vastly changing world, this reality of vocation has remain unchanged. What our late pope was describing was a his experience of God calling him to the priesthood. Today we join Our Lord and the apostles shortly after He called them. He is sending them out with strict instructions to pack light and how they are to act depending on how they are treated. These simple instructions could not have prepared them for what they were about to experience. Taking Jesus at His word, they could not have expected to be casting out demons and healing sick people. They were simply doing their best to answer God's call and live in the mystery of His love for them. Sometimes people seem to get upset with God because they want definitive answers or they put conditions on answering His call. Like so many things in this world of access to information and instant gratification we tend to reject God's biddings because he seems to provide neither. Like the Apostles we need to trust first, realize we will be surprised along our way and be humble. God and His work in our lives will always be a mystery, are we up for the journey?
