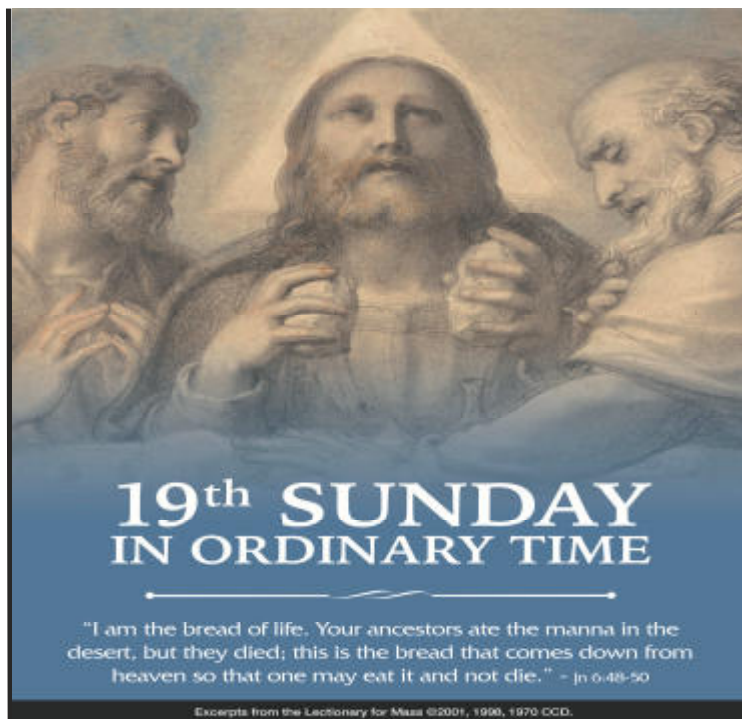

Dear family,

For the next two weeks we welcome to the parish Archbishop Sheehan and Fr. Frank Pretto. Your pastor will be taking vacation. Considering that we don't get weekends off and only one day each week, these breaks are nice to refresh and renew ourselves. Even us priests need vacations where no ministry or administration is involved, and as usual, if you are a Facebook user you can follow my journey at my profile "Daniel Gutierrez." Please pray that this time is renewing for me so as to come back and work hard as your pastor, which is my true joy.

In our Gospel this weekend, Jesus reminds us that the "Bread of Life" that He has been addressing to us these past few weeks is more than just physical bread, as a matter of fact, He is not really talking about bread at all, but the life-giving relationship between the Father and the Son, the same relationship that has been for all eternity and which is now offered to us through Jesus in the sacraments of His Church. In other words, what we do in ritual is a reflection of who we are and where we stand with God, or at least it should. In the end, though, it is our choice whether or not we will allow ourselves to reflect a change and a love within us after having received these mysteries. Consider these two quotes from St. John Chrysostom, one of the greatest preachers of our Faith: "The transformation on the altar means little if there is no transformation in us." Or, "What good does it do to reverence the presence of Christ in the Host if we neglect Him in the beggar at the door of the Church?" My family, it is certainly easy to fall into a minimalism with our faith by just jumping through the religious hoops, but this misses the point: receiving communion is important and necessary, but not sufficient to BEING in communion with God, that is up to us.
