pastor's Corner

Dear family,

There is a story about a new priest who was just appointed by his bishop as pastor of his very first parish. With starry eyes, the young cleric, intent on spreading the Gospel message to his new congregation, decided to hold a meeting with the various ministry heads and council chairs upon his first visit. This would be a meeting where Father could share his vision and learn more about the parish, its history and its people. The excitement only built as he heard from the people just how wonderful his new parish was, but this ended in a sad turn for the worst. He asked the people, what is the goal of this parish? One person cited the need for more money, another said the parish should keep its traditions alive and yet another said that the parish was to be a community partner. The priest bowed his head in sadness, because there was one answer he didn't hear at all: the salvation of souls!

Dear friends, there was nothing wrong with what any of the parishioners had said. The problem was not in what they said, but in where their minds were and thus in what they forgot. I don't know why our human nature can be so fickle at times. I do know that society sure doesn't help and sometimes the "values" of society contradict those of the Gospel. As we see in today's Gospel, even the Apostles were not immune to forgetting their mission. Enamored by what the world cherished, they wanted nothing to do with sacrifice and everything to do with political power. With the exception of being persecuted at times unjustly, I am convinced that most problems the Church faces is due to this attitude. May we choose Christ fully and follow Him with a pure and open heart!
