### pastor's Corner

Dear family,

Of all the tactics the evil one sometimes uses to attack our Church, jealousy is one of the genius approaches. Like greed, when one

gives into jealousy, it slowly starts to destroy relationships. It starts with what seems like a petty competition: "I want that thing too." Jealousy begins with an interest in a thing and ends with a hatred of the person who possesses what we do not or cannot have. As the victim mentality brought about by the jealous mind simmers over time, it can even boil over painting the other person as "the enemy" no matter the good they are doing. This is not to say that there exist those who egg on a competition or hold something over another's head, but the jealous heart will play right into this game. Before one knows it, even the good that they seek to do is diminished and demeaned by the fact that they have prevented others from doing it. Consider the beginning of a potentially dangerous situation that starts with jealousy in today's first reading and Gospel. Angry that they no longer have a monopoly over God's grace, John and Joshua, are ready to stop legitimate people from doing God's work and helping others. Moses and Our Lord, of course, rebuke their petty behavior pointing out that the mission is more important than who is participating in it. So dangerous and cancerous is jealousy that it can enroot itself into even the most sacred of circles preventing God's will from being done. When we realize that our gifts are just that, given, and when we place less emphasis on getting credit, we can see clearly. But as it is, many remain blinded by jealousy and only see what they don't have or aren't recognized for, but this is neither here nor there in God's sight.
