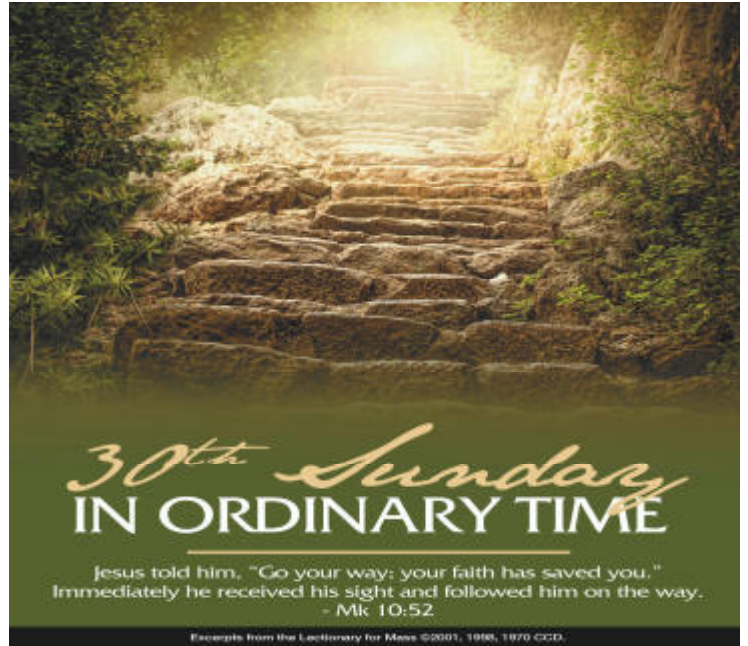

astor's Corner

Dear family,

Hello, from the Holy Land! I write this corner as our group drives back from the Dead Sea to Bethlehem where our hotel is. Being here has been so transformative and awe inspiring. The Holy Land is a sort of "fifth Gospel" that makes the others come to life and give concreteness to the actions of God we read about every day at the liturgy. As I write, our bus is passing back through the town of Jericho mentioned in today's Gospel. This is a city accustomed to turmoil, destruction and seemingly endless rebuilding. The present city, now one of the world's oldest inhabited places, sits on the rubble of many cities that have come before it. It is an old place, to say the least. After already much history and the collapse of its walls when Elijah marched on it with God's help, the Son of God passes through it and about to leave the town, he meets Bartimaeus. Bartimaeus reaches out to Jesus and calls his name with persistence to ask for healing. Even discouraged by some, Bartimaeus cries out all the more. Catching Jesus' attention, he is healed. Even in an old place, Jesus can do something new and create sight where there was darkness. Bartimaeus, we are told, immediately follows after Jesus. What is our reaction to the times when Jesus heals us with a consoling word, when he forgives our sins in the confessional? Do we follow him transformed or remain in our old ways? Let God make you new and then make resolve to remain changed forever.

Know of my prayers for all of you as we pass through these holy sites. I love you all and hope to return to you all the more zealous for our faith! Blessings!
