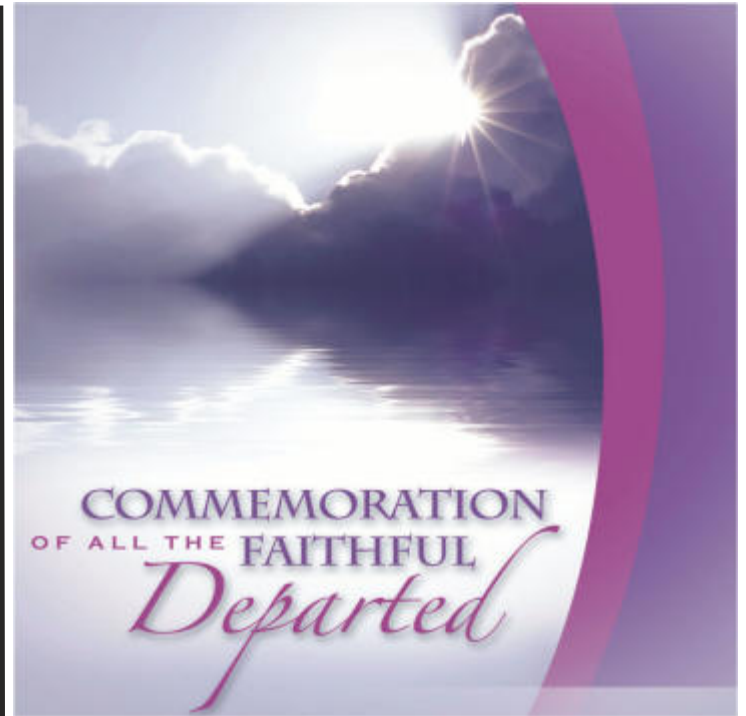

The candles burn close to our Lord on the Altar. Intentions can be in memory of a loved one, a special request, or in thanksgiving to our Lord.

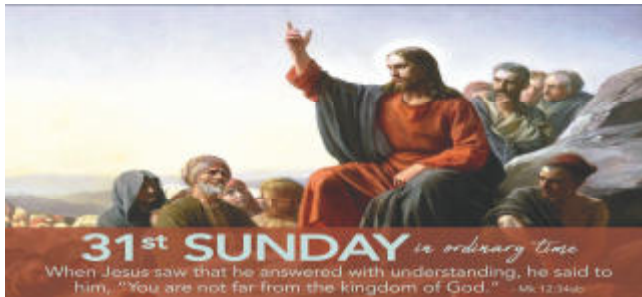

## Pastor's Corner



Dear family,

What does it take to be a good Christian? If you asked some faithful, they might respond that it requires fulfilling requirements such as going to Mass and Confession. Others might cite the precepts and laws that we follow as Catholics. All religious obligations and theological content aside, there is one thing missing from these answers: love! Our Lord reminds us of this absolutely necessary ingredient in His Word today. When questioned by a scribe of the law which law is the greatest, Jesus cites some scripture that the scribe would be all too familiar with, because it comes from the Torah (the first five books of the Old Testament). Jesus acknowledging this important call showed that the love we have for God and our neighbor is not just important but necessary. It's not just the what, but the how. Without love, friends, a true sign of discipleship in Christ, even a great amount of actions and all the devotion in the world is left dry and void of meaning. It was love that propelled Jesus to give us everything and when He has nothing left to give, He was moved out of Love for us to give us His very life!
