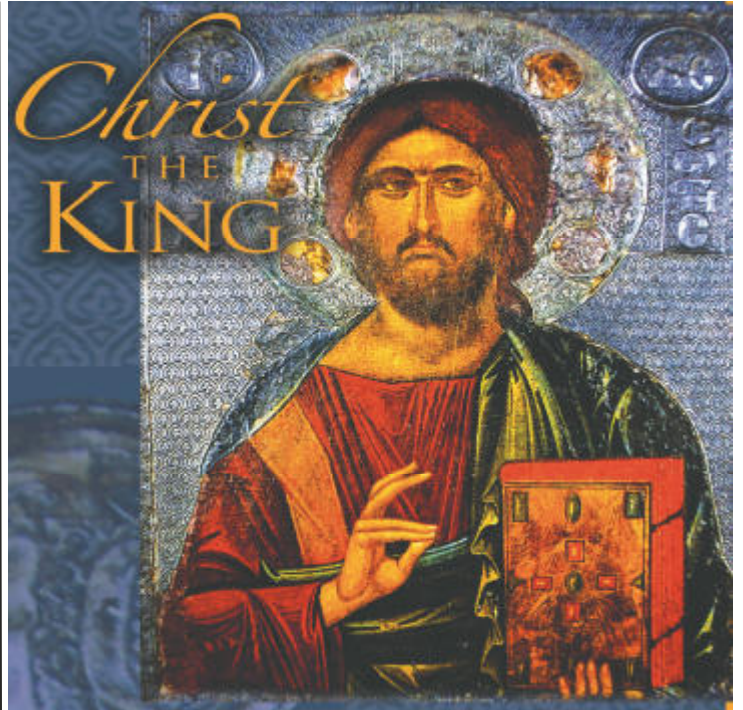

Pastor's Corner

Dear family,

About a month ago to this date, I can still remember standing outside of the place where Jesus wept over Jerusalem. There is built a church, *Dominus Flevit*, which looks out over the entire valley toward Jerusalem from the Mount of Olives. It felt like I was standing in the center of the universe as this was the place where God and man's history had collided. It is the place of much controversy and standing there, there was not one direction one could look without seeing a place sacred to one or more of the three major Western religions. As the tour guide was pointing out the various sacred sites of our faith, including the dome of the Church of Holy Sepulcher, he mentioned something interesting. It would have been relatively at the same time that both Jesus and Pontius Pilate would have ridden into Jerusalem. Pilate came in a celebratory fashion after having won a battle for the Roman Empire; he marched into town with a victory parade with his soldiers. Meanwhile, descending down the Mount of Olives about a week before the events of His trial, passion, death, and resurrection would have been Our Lord. The people with palm branches in hand would we are told would have greeted Jesus riding a donkey. One entrance would have been a glorious display of militaristic might and the other a heartfelt procession where those poor in spirit would have looked on with hope at their Savior. Humble but full of integrity, Jesus stands as our king. Without something to prove and with no need to impress others, Christ is a king that leads with a confidence that is unassuming. Are we content with this form of leadership? Do we identify with this King of ours or we do we rank Him in terms of the other influences in our lives? Which parade would we find ourselves in, shouting for the warrior leader or joyously welcoming the man on the donkey?
