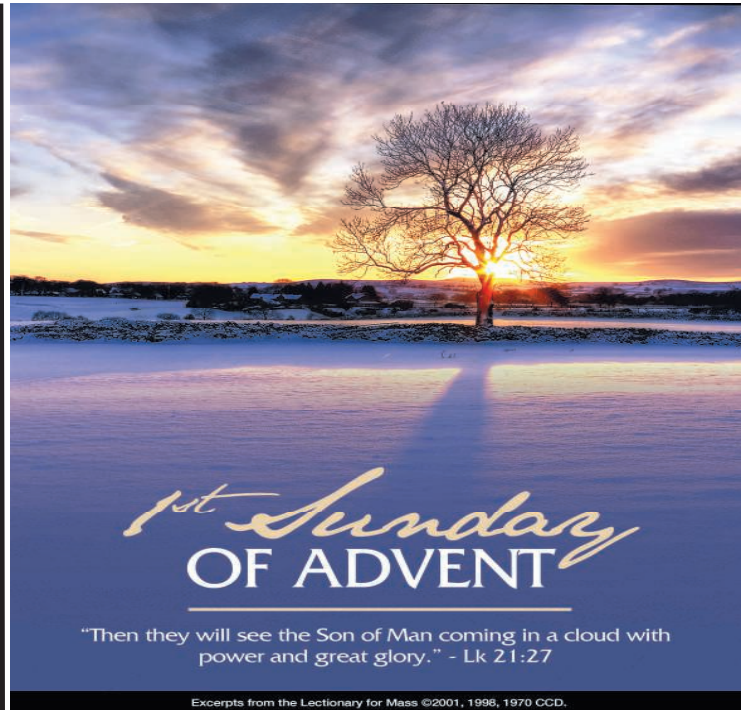

Pastor's Corner

Dear family,

Jesus exhorts us today: "...stand erect and raise your heads because your redemption is at hand." We are called to "vigilant" and alert for the moment when Our Lord comes back to reconcile all things, to take us to Himself. We are no stranger to this call, because we hear it so clearly every Advent, which is a season of preparation for Jesus's coming at Christmas and at the end of the ages. I am afraid, however, that sometimes this plea is misunderstood. First of all, do we realize that this world is unsatisfying? Have we come to understand that while this world reflects God's beauty, truth, and goodness in many brilliant ways, it is only a reflection, and reflections don't satisfy, not completely? This is to say, is there a place in our hearts reserved for and in set in anticipation of Jesus? Second, are we attentive to God's presence in our life now? Privileged as we are to have so many close encounters with the living God (e.g. the sacraments, the proclaimed Word), do we revel in this gift and hang on His every word? Clergy and lay folk both are prone to that temptation to simply "go through the motions" in such sacred and grace-filled moments. Brothers and sisters, do we realize the immense gift we have in Jesus being present to us and for us in the Eucharist, accessible to our community twenty-four hours a day and practically every day of the year? Finally, do we get that the second coming of Jesus is actually an exciting and good thing? Jesus says it perfectly, "your redemption is at hand." Like with so many things in life and in our faith, we need to take a step toward maturity in realizing that the second coming is happening "for" us and not "to" us. Jesus comes to reconcile our lives and relationships, He comes to give us peace He who is peace! I cannot speak for other denominations, but us Catholic Christians are given this announcement as something that should thrill us, more than any experience we have anticipated before. Jesus' is very good news, because it's our hope. May we embrace our God now and grow in yearning for His presence and His love. In His expectant joy, Fr. Daniel
