Padre's Corner

Dear Family,

We now enter the most sacred days our faith celebrates, our high holy days, Holy Week. We hear and look in detail on the core of the greatest story ever told. These "moments" of our story are the basis for all we believe. So where does our focus lie? Are we resolved to follow after Him? The Pharisees cannot even begin to entertain the idea that Jesus is who He says He is. The apostles find it too hard, too much to stay by His side. And the crowd, well, they do what crowds do: they are swayed by drama and excitement. Many people then as now find it very hard to stick with him. He demands too much, he says things that are hard to live by and usually are unpopular.

I lead you as your pastor, but I also walk with you as a fellow disciple. As a fellow disciple, I can easily admit it is easy to avoid Jesus; it is sometimes more comfortable to pretend He wasn't real or that His words don't really matter. But they do matter, He matters. As we hear the passion, there are so many people who choose not to see or listen to Jesus, to discredit Him. At one point, the Pharisees would actually put a murderer and known criminal on the street before they drop the ridiculous charges against Our Lord and hear Him out. Dear friends, as we tell this part of the story that changed the world, keep in mind whose voice you choose to hear, whose face you choose to see. There are some loud, authoritative, learned, and interesting people acting and speaking, but only one faces death and comes out victorious. Only one's voice and image changed the world and can change our lives. See and hear Him. Stay by Him throughout this week and throughout your lives, because His presence alone gives life and conquers death.
