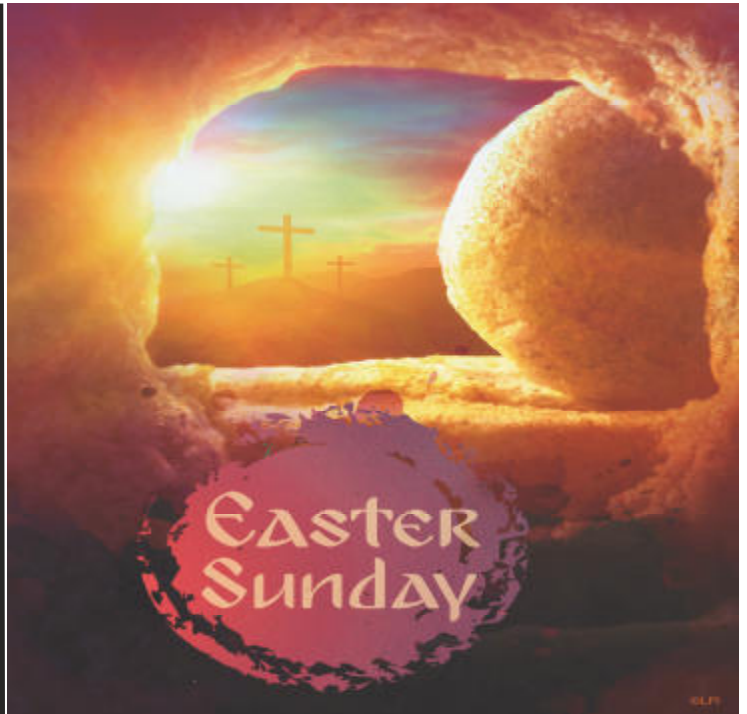

Dear Family,
