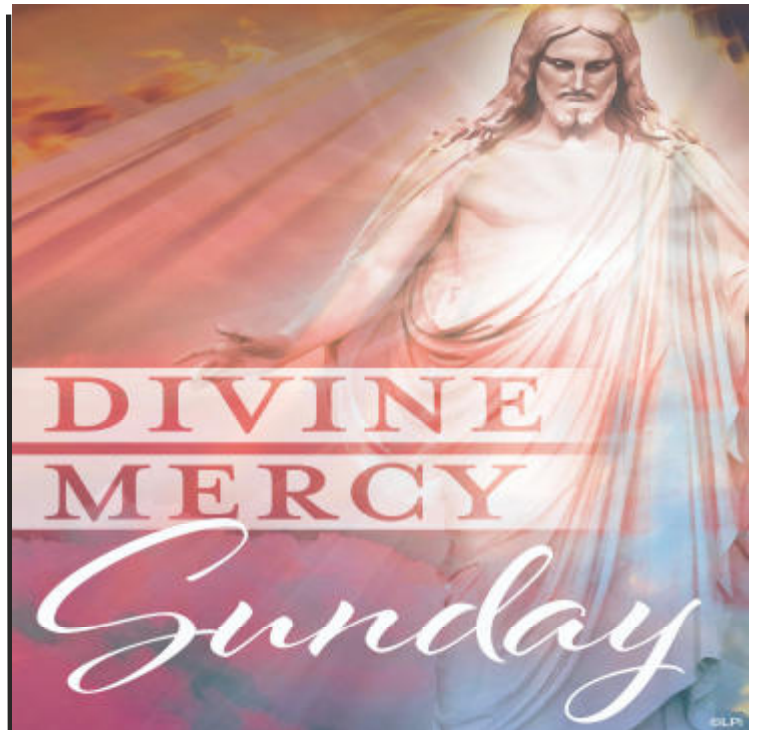

Padre's Corner

Dear Family,

It is a tradition on this second Sunday of Easter to celebrate the popular devotion/experience/testimony that we now know as Divine Mercy. So many lives have been touched by this phenomenon where Our Lord spoke to St. Faustina, the Polish nun who was blessed to hear many personal revelations about God's splendid mercy. Good thing they were not kept private, as they have helped many to understand that the heart of God, while just, is indeed incredibly merciful. We Catholics are doubly blessed to be able to know firsthand the mercy of God in a special and concentrated way in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Scripturally, it is this Sunday's Gospel which reminds us that Jesus gave the Apostles (and later passed on to their successors, our bishops and priests) the ability to forgive sins. What a gift the Risen Jesus gives us, His Church! It is a gift flowing from Jesus' Resurrection that our sins are forgiven in the confessional. Like the messages conveyed to St. Faustina, so the mercy we receive at the words of the priest and through the Holy Spirit in the confessional is plentiful, absolute, solemn, and transforming. Our experience in this world, may at times lead us to believe that when God forgives us He still keeps a record of our sins looming over our head, but this is not so. When we are sent forth from receiving the Sacrament, we go forward exactly like the day we were baptized: completely loved and actually empowered. Never remain far from confession, my family, God wants to always show you the power of His Divine Mercy!
