Adult Question: When you yourself pause to be alone with God, what distracts and prevents you from dwelling in that? Busyness? The demands of life? TV? The internet?

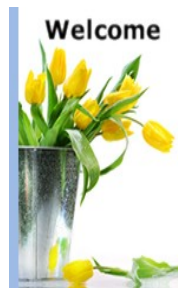
Youth Question: Jesus was tempted by the devil. How are you tempted? What helps you resist these temptations?
