NEW POLICY ON RENTAL OF PARISH HALL: I want to make everyone aware of some new policies that have come from our Insurance Company and the Diocese. In order to rent the parish hall, we have to have proof of insurance for the event and there are a couple of ways that you can do this.

- 1) you can go to your homeowners insurance and request a certificate from them - you have to have at least \$1 million in liability per event and the certificate of insurance must name our parish and the Diocese as an additional insured. It is not adequate to obtain a certificate of insurance, which names the parish as a "certificate holder." I also want to make you aware that some insurance companies have not renewed policies after this has been requested!
- 2) or you can purchase a one time "Special Event" coverage thru Catholic Mutual (the parish's insurance company) - the cost for this is \$95 payable at the time of use. There is paperwork that needs to be filled out, which I have here in the office, and sent in to Catholic Mutual - we need to have this into Catholic Mutual 15 days prior (there are some exceptions) but please do not wait until the last minute to get this into me.
- 3) Anything that is parish sponsored is covered under our plan thru Catholic Mutual (i.e. funeral dinners, chicken noodle dinner, breakfasts, sewing day).
