Deacon Tim's Reflection

We are creatures of habit finding comfort in the familiar. Anyone who has boated on Lake Mead knows this. We find comfort going to our favorite fishing holes because of success. We find comfort in going to the same beach because we are familiar with it. We find comfort in the same launch area because we use it all the time.

Boating on Lake Mead is great fun especially when the weather is beautiful, no wind and the surface is like glass which is perfect for skiing, fishing, swimming or just floating. Reading this week's Gospel, I imagine when the disciples launched their boat it was just as perfect a day and they had no cares, they would go out and then back for Jesus.

However, like Lake Mead the Sea of Galilee is subject to unexpected winds that turn the smooth surface into white caps and rollers that can toss a boat around mightily. The sudden change brings out fear, causing uncertainty and anxiety as it was for the disciples in that moment before they spotted Jesus walking across the water. It is the same in everyday life too. We become afraid and full of anxiety even though we know Jesus is always with us. And, like Peter we want to walk over the torrent with Him, however, like Peter it just seems impossible and overwhelming. The Gospel reminds us Jesus is always there with a hand to lift us from the storm, just reach.
