#### Reflection on a Tragic Event

After the very tragic event in Las Vegas this week people are having different reactions depending how closely they were affected by shootings. Some in our parish were very close to some of the victims while many not so close. However, when a tragedy of this magnitude occurs in our country it likely ripples across the country like a boulder on a small pond. This rippling, like the aftershocks of an earthquake leaves behind trauma in the form of shock, sadness, stress, hopelessness and a shaking of faith.

Although, when there is a strong community of faith such as we have in Southern Nevada and especially here at St. Andrew, there is an even greater ripple, a tsunami of love, hope and faith that shatters the evil and brings light to the darkness. As strong as our faith may be, we must also be aware of the psychological trauma these events cause even though we are not directly affected. Take inventory of your emotions in the coming weeks, are you not sleeping, are you obsessed with following the news all day and night, do you continue to feel sadness and hopelessness, are you feeling stressed? If so, please seek out professional mental health care.

Here at St. Andrew we will continue to support each other with our love of God and love of neighbor. We will let our lights shine for all in darkness and pray for those in need. All are welcome in this house.
