**A Gospel Reflection**

**Love of God and Neighbor Are Inseparable**

*Excerpts from a homily by Pope Francis*

“At your home, within your own [domestic] church, are you generous and are you fair with those who are your dependents, be they your children, your grandparents, your employees?”

Love of God and love of our neighbor is one and the same thing; and if you want to show genuine and not just formal penance, you must show it before God and also towards your brothers. This charity ought to be practiced at home within one’s family, at work with one’s employees and colleagues and with the needy.”

Pope Francis in his homily gave particular emphasis to prisoners, asking those present if they had room in their hearts for those who have made mistakes and are now in jail. He stated that to say that you don’t associate with “those type of people” is wrong. “If you yourself are not in prison it’s because Our Lord has helped you not to sin.”

“Do you pray for (prisoners), so that the Lord can help them to change their lives?” he asked.
