Resurrection Reflection

On the evening of the resurrection, the disciples were gathered in fear behind locked doors. They were overjoyed when the Risen Lord appeared in their midst with a greeting of “peace” (Hebrew, *Shalom*). He shows them his wounded hands and side. Jesus said to them again, “Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you.” And when he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, “Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them and Whose sins you retain are retained.” Jesus gave them the authority to take away people’s sins through the power of the Holy Spirit.

Thomas, called Didymus meaning “twin,” was absent on this occasion and refused to believe their testimony.

A week later his disciples were again inside and Thomas was now with them. The Risen Christ appeared again. When Thomas touched Christ’s wounds he declared Jesus to be his “Lord and God.” Jesus told Thomas that those who have faith and believe without seeing are more blessed than those who need visible proof.

My Lord and God, help us to believe when our faith wavers.
