**Visitation House Baby Bottle Fundraiser  
Begins This Weekend - Mother's Day**

The Catholic Parishes of Millbury are participating in a Baby Bottle Fundraiser to benefit Visitation House, a Catholic home for homeless women facing crisis pregnancies. Since opening in 2005 on the feast of the Visitation, they have cared for over 200 mothers and their babies. While women await the birth of their babies at the home on Vernon Hill in Worcester, MA, Visitation House feeds, clothes, educates and nurtures them. After the birth of their baby, mothers can stay up to six months and during that time the staff at Visitation House assists them with housing, higher education, job opportunities and furnishes them with the basic necessities to start their new lives. Please support Visitation House by taking a baby bottle on the weekend of May 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>, and filling it with your spare money. We ask that you return your bottle on Father's Day weekend, June 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup>.

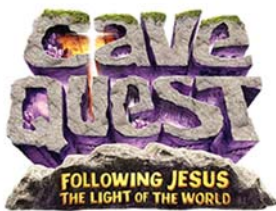

### The Angelus

The Angelus is a devotional prayer commemorating the Incarnation. It is practiced by reciting, as verse and response, three Scripture verses narrating the mystery of the Incarnation and alternating with the Hail Mary.

Traditionally, this devotion was recited in churches, convents, and monasteries three times daily, at 6:00 AM, noon, and 6:00 PM. The Angelus is usually accompanied by the ringing of the Angelus bell which is a call to prayer and to spread good-will to everyone. The angel referred to in the prayer is Gabriel, a messenger of God, who revealed to Mary that she was to be the Mother of God.

During this month of May, the Church traditionally honors Mary, the Mother of Jesus, our Lord and Savior. During this month, we also celebrate and remember our mothers.

Together let us pray "The Angelus" in appreciation for the gift of our mothers.

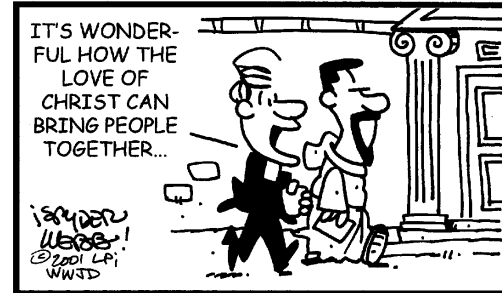
