Newspaper, Magazines, Junk Mail, Colored Paper, Paper Bags, File Folders, Phone Books, Cards	GLASS Garbage, Soiled Pizza Boxes
Cardboard and Paperboard	Plastic Bags
Plastics #1 - #5 and and #7	Styrofoam
Metal Pots and Pans	Paper Towels and Napkins Facial and Toilet Tissue
Empty Aerosol Cans	Coat Hangers
Aluminum Cans and Foil	Paint and Solvent Containers
Steel and Tin Cans	Light bulbs, Mirrors, Windows

Commonly Mistaken Unacceptable Material : PLASTIC BAGS, STYROFOAM, GLASS, Wrapping Paper, Used Pizza Boxes, Coat Hangers, Paint and Solvent Containers, Light Bulbs, Mirrors, Windows, Dishes and Cups, Pyrex Pans, Wet or Soiled Paper, Paper Towels, Facial and Toilet Tissue, Disposable Plates and Cups

Residential Recycling

The following items are accepted:

Paper: Newspaper, Magazines, Catalogs, Junk Mail and Envelopes, Office Paper, Construction Paper, Colored Paper, Folders, Paper Bags, Phone Books, Holiday Cards and Greeting Cards

Cardboard: Corrugated Cardboard Boxes, Paperboard Boxes (cereal, soda/beer, egg, shoe boxes, etc.)

Containers: Aluminum Cans, Tin Cans, Steel Cans, Empty Aerosol Cans, Aluminum Foil, Plastics #1-#5 and #7 (milk, soda, water, juice, shampoo, detergent, pool supplies, pet food, etc., excluding Styrofoam), Metal Pots and Pans, Copper, Scrap Metal (nails and screws, gutters, etc.)

Unacceptable Recyclable Material: PLASTIC BAGS, GLASS, Styrofoam, Pizza Boxes (because of the oils), Coat Hangers, Paint and Solvent Containers, Light Bulbs, Mirrors, Windows, Dishes and Cups, Pyrex Pans, Wet or Soiled Paper, Paper Towels, Facial and Toilet Tissue, Disposable Plates and Cups, Milk and Juice Cartons (wax-board containers), Wrapping Paper

The Montgomery County Recycling Center Precinct 2 is located at 31354 Friendship Drive, Magnolia, Texas and they are currently accepting paper, cardboard, aluminum, clear and brown glass jars and bottles, plastic containers, electronics, tires, mixed metal cans and clean plastic bags. Their hours are Monday through Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
