

ORDINANCE # 299

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF A 1% SALES AND USE TAX FROM BUSINESSES OPERATING WITHIN THE CITY OF STAGECOACH, TEXAS THIS REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

WHEREAS, SECTION 53.01 OF THE TEXAS TAX CODE PROVIDES FOR A CUIT SALES TAX

There is imposed, pursuant to the provisions of Texas Tax Code 521.001 et seq. a 1% local sales and use tax within the city to pay the costs of land, building, equipment, facilities, and improvements for additional purposes authorized by state law.

WHEREAS, SECTION 5113 OF THE TEXAS TAX CODE PROVIDES FOR THE RATE OF TAX.

The City Council hereby declares that a 1% local sales and use tax within the city limits of Stagecoach, Texas has been properly and lawfully adopted at a general election therefore held May 7, 1998 in accordance with the provisions of state law and is hereby levied within the city

WHEREAS, all notices and hearings required by law as a prerequisite to the passage, approval, and adoption of said tax rate ordinance have been timely and properly given and held now, heretofore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STAGECOACH, TEXAS:

Section 1. The facts and recitations set forth in the preamble of this Ordinance are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted, ratified, and confirmed

Section 2. All businesses subject to the sales and use tax by the City of Stagecoach, Texas, shall be equally and lawfully subject to the tax of 1% of sales.

Section 3. There is hereby levied for general purposes and use by the City of Stagecoach, Texas a sales and use tax of 1% of sales.

Section 4. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.
