An Intimate Encounter with the Living God

Join our very own Fr Brian for a silent day of prayer at the Retreat Center on Wednesday, April 13th. The retreat starts at 9:00 AM and will conclude at 3:00 PM. *Lectio Divina* is a prayer practice that uses Sacred Scripture as a context for prayer. It includes four basic steps where one reads God's Word to meditate, pray and contemplate. We cannot practice *lectio divina* without being changed, so come and find out how to do it!

Life Line Screening Event

Following the success of last summer's Life Line Screening, we are pleased to again offer a preventive health event. Life Line Screening, a leading provider of community-based preventive health screenings, will host their affordable, non-invasive and painless health screenings here on **Friday, April 8th**. Five screenings will be offered that scan for potential health problems related to: blocked arteries which is a leading cause of stroke; abdominal aortic aneurysms which can lead to a ruptured aorta; hardening of the arteries in the legs which is a strong predictor of heart disease; atrial fibrillation or irregular heart beat which is closely tied to stroke risk; and a bone density screening, for men and women, used to assess the risk of osteoporosis. Register for a Wellness Package which includes four vascular tests and osteoporosis screening from \$149. All five screenings take 60-90 minutes to complete.
