
## Guatemala Book Sale

## Calling All Cursillistas

The *Cursillo* focuses on showing Christian lay people how to become effective Christian leaders over the course of a three-day weekend. The weekend includes fifteen talks, some given by priests and some by lay people. The major emphasis of the weekend is to ask participants to take what they have learned back into the world, on what is known as the "fourth day." The method stresses personal spiritual development, as accelerated by weekly group reunions (after the weekend).



*Ultreya* is a Spanish word, derived from the original Latin, meaning *onward!* As its name implies, the *Ultreya*, is a call to move forward and to keep the flame of the Cursillo burning brightly.


