### Christmas Tree Sales



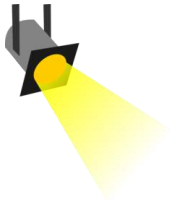
Sign ups for Christmas tree sales have been sent. Please be sure to check

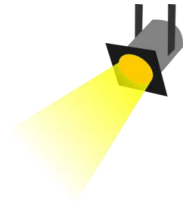

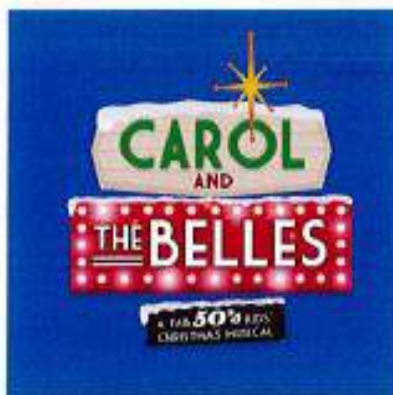
