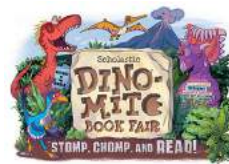


Passion Play

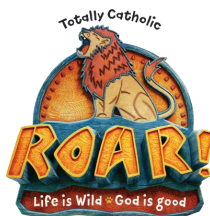

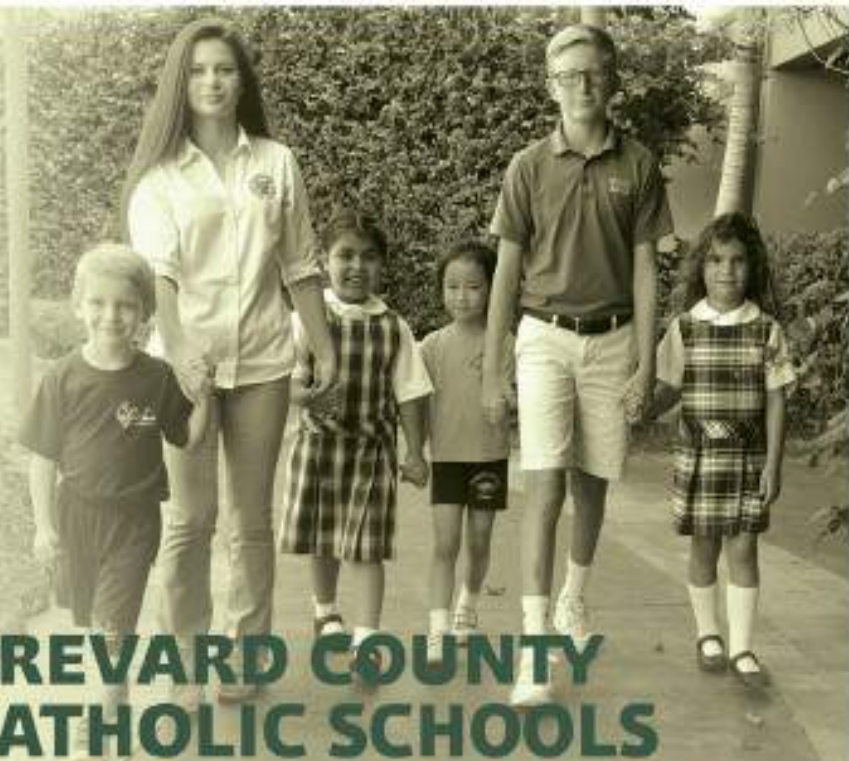
