POPE DENOUNCES "SLANDEROUS COMMUNICATION" OF DICTATORSHIPS

If you want to destroy institutions or people, you start by speaking ill of them. This is the "slandering communication" that Pope Francis exhorted Christians to watch out against. The Pope was reflecting on the episode in the First Book of Kings, where Jezebel, the cruel wife of King Ahab of Samaria, used slander and falsehood to have Naboth killed in order to take possession of his vineyard which her husband greatly coveted. The Pope described Naboth as a "martyr of fidelity to the inheritance" that he had received from his forefathers: "an inheritance of the heart". Pope Francis pointed out that even today this method of slanderous communication is used in many countries. The Pope said all dictatorships began by adulterating communication by putting it in the hands of an unscrupulous person or government. This also happens in daily life, the Pope pointed out, saying one begins to destroy a person by starting with communication – speaking ill of others, slandering and spreading scandals, which he said have great seductive power. The Pope said many persons and nations have been destroyed by evil and slanderous dictatorships. The Pope said James the Apostle speaks precisely of the "destructive capacity of evil communication". The Holy Father thus exhorted Christians to re-read the episode of Naboth and think of the many people and countries destroyed by dictatorships of 'white gloves'.

PÁPEŽ FRANTIŠEK: OČIERŇOVANIE RUINUJE OSOBY I KRAJINY

Ak niekto chce zničiť inštitúcie alebo ľudí, začne ich očierňovať. Využíva sa na to mediálna sila škandálu. Pápež František vyzýva mať sa na pozore pred „očierňovacou komunikáciou“. Jeho zamyslenie vychádza z príbehu o Nabotovi, z Knihy kráľov (1 Kr 21, 1-16). Kráľ Achab túži po Nabotovej vinici a ponúkne mu peniaze. Tá pôda je však časťou dedičstva jeho otcov, a preto odmietne. Na radu krutej manželky Jezabel dá kráľ obviniť Nabota z rúhania a zabiť ho a takto sa zmocní jeho vinice. Nabot – poznamenal pápež – je teda „mučeníkom vernosti dedičstvu“, ktoré dostal od svojich otcov, dedičstvu, ktoré je viac ako vinica, „dedičstvu srdca“. „Aj v bežnom živote je to tak“, podčiarkol pápež František ak sa chce zničiť človek, „začne sa komunikáciou, ohovárať, očierňovať, rozprávať škandály“. A takto tá komunikácia narastá, a dotyčná osoba, inštitúcia či krajina skončí ako ruina. Je to metóda diktatúr. Najprv zruinovať, potom odsúdiť. Pápež potom pripomenul, že zlomyseľnou komunikáciou bolo zničených množstvo ľudí. Prvý krok je zmocniť sa komunikácie, a potom deštrukcia, odsúdenie a smrť.“ Práve o „deštruktívnej schopnosti zlomyseľnej komunikácie“ hovorí apoštol Jakub, pripomenul na záver pápež František a odporúčal znovu si prečítať biblický príbeh o Nabotovi z 21. kapitoly Prvej knihy kráľov a myslieť na „mnohých zničených ľudí, na mnohé zničené krajiny, na mnohé diktatúry v „bielych rukavičkách“, ktoré zničili krajiny.
