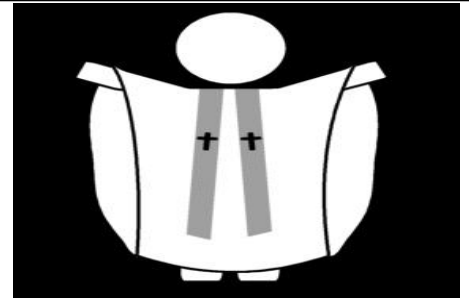

Discernment Evenings at the house of Discernment

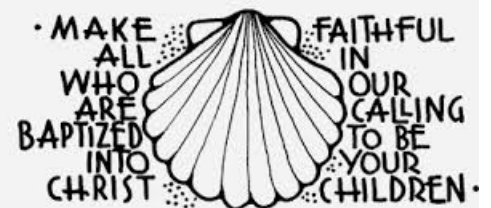
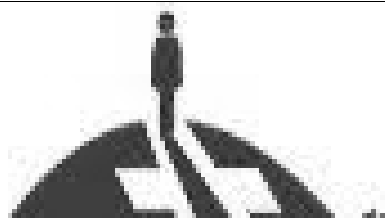
