From The Pastor's Desk

Readings: Moses assures the people of God's law is not distinct or mysterious, but close to them already "in your mouths and in your hearts." In the response, we are to turn to the Lord in our need and He will care for us. Paul gives us an early Christological Hymn. It was meant to teach about Christ, so it is full of Theology. Christ has reconciled all creation by the blood of His cross.

Gospel: Religious teachers were supposed to know how to attain salvation. You will notice the lawyer did not quote the Ten Commandments, to love God and neighbor. There was debate whether neighbor meant only fellow Jews who lived close by or whether it meant more than that. You will notice Jesus applies neighbor to all, even hated Samaritans.

My assignment as Pastor at St. Mary ends on 12 July. We are happy with the replacements. I could picture it being a bit unpleasant. I have enjoyed my time here. I hope you also enjoyed it and appreciate the joy of the Christian message. I have been privileged to meet and work with so many wonderful people. I encourage you to be as nice to my replacements.
