The Mass will conclude with a Holy Hour and a rosary for peace and healing. The Mass is being celebrated in conjunction with the Diocesan Office of Black Catholic Ministries. In light of the conflict at times between the African American community and law enforcement that has led to the unnecessary loss of life in several cities, better communication and healing are necessary between the two communities. Our prayers can be a large factor in bringing communities together. Black Catholic Ministries believes that **all lives matter** – Black Lives matter, Blue Lives Matter, White Lives Matter – and that we must promote understanding and communication among the different groups of our society. This understanding begins when we open lines of communication that result in constructive dialogue. The Church can be instrumental in promoting such dialogue through prayer and worship services.
