First Friday ... Eucharistic Devotion ... Reconciliation

The Holy Eucharist is the Source and Summit of our Faith ... and of our Lives! Such is the joyful acclamation of Vatican II and all the Catholic hearts over the centuries who love the Eucharist. In the Mass we consume our Lord's Body and Blood and receive God's Grace for our journeys of faith. From the Mass the Lord abides with us in the consecrated Host for our continued Adoration.

A great devotion of the Catholic Church is the Exposition and Adoration of the Lord upon the Altar and Benediction. This gives a special opportunity to contemplate his Presence with us in the Blessed Sacrament. It's an intimate time to say, "Thank you, Jesus," as we adore and worship him. St. Mary Parish will institute this devotion on a regular basis on First Friday of each month, beginning October 7, which coincidentally is the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary.

Immediately following the morning Mass, a consecrated Host will be placed in the Monstrance on the Altar for Adoration. You are invited to sign up in advance for a period of Adoration. Please contact the parish office or sign the Adoration time sheet in the church vestibule to indicate your interest in a half-hour period (or more). Adoration will conclude with Benediction at Noon. The Sacrament of Reconciliation will be offered during Adoration immediately after the Exposition.
