- ❖ Bishop Campbell has designated the catechumens and candidates of St. Mary, Groveport RCIA among the "Elect." They're moving forward enthusiastically toward full communion with the Catholic Church. Two will be baptized, confirmed and receive first Holy Communion at the Easter Vigil: Gregg Ferguson and Taylor Angle. Three who were baptized in other Christian traditions will be received through Confirmation and Communion: Jo Ellen Albanese, Jeff Ruehle and Marlin Hambrick. Jason Huston was baptized as an infant in the Catholic Church but did not proceed with catechesis and other Sacraments of Initiation: the Bishop will confirm Jason in the Cathedral at 10:30 a.m., Saturday, March 25.
- A beautiful liturgy in Holy Week is the **Chrism Mass** at 6:00 p.m., Tuesday, April 11. The priests renew their ordination vows.
