Confraternity of Christian Doctrine. The Confraternity of Christian Doctrine was an association established at Rome in 1562 for the purpose of giving religious education. Its modern usage, often abbreviated **CCD** or **C.C.D.**, is a religious education program of the Roman Catholic Church, normally designed for children.
