Location: Sacred Heart Catholic School Art Room The art room has an east facing entry on the south end of the school. There will be a sign to direct you to the correct entrance.

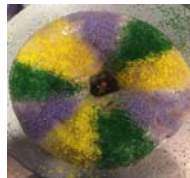
