Dear Parents/ Guardians,

Welcome to the 2019-2020 school year. My name is Marianne Crocco and I will be your child's Pre-K 3 teacher. I anticipate a school year filled with caring, learning, growing, exploring, and lots of laughter. To prepare your child for a wonderful school year, please provide the following on the *first* day of school:

Please make sure everything is labeled with your child's name!

- a *large* backpack
- Art smock (Dad's old T-shirt is best)
- a change of clothes (shirt, pants, socks, underwear) Place all inside a Ziploc Bag. Please note this does *not* need to be a uniform.
- crib sheet and blanket for nap time (only full day students) Place inside a reusable canvas bag.
- lunch box (only full day students)

I will be providing a folder which will go home with your child on the first day of school. Please check and empty this folder daily. Here you will find your child's school work and any important notices from the school. Also, if you have any written correspondence for me or the school, please place it in this folder as well.

A *healthy snack* will be provided daily by me for all children. I ask that you pay \$4 cash per month in a clearly marked envelope with your child's name. Please let me know of any allergies your child may have!

In addition, please note that beginning in September and other various times throughout the year a notice will go home in your child's folder as to what classroom cleaning supplies are needed (tissues, wipes, etc...). This will help to keep our classroom clean and hopefully germ free throughout the year.

Pre-K 3 will also be participating in Computer, Art, Library, Spanish, Music, and Physical Education classes. I will let you know those days and times in September as well.
