Dear Parish Family,

Today, we honor and wish all fathers a Happy Father's Day! We thank them for everything they do for us and their families. 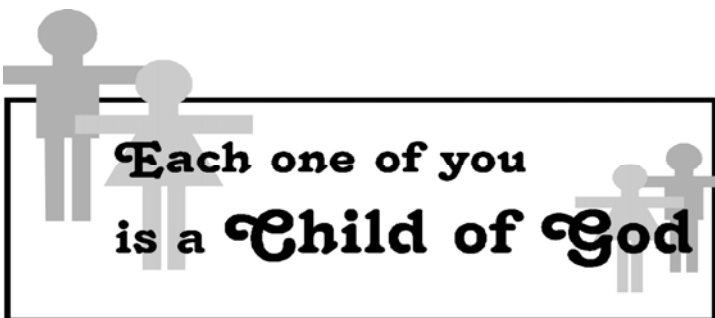
