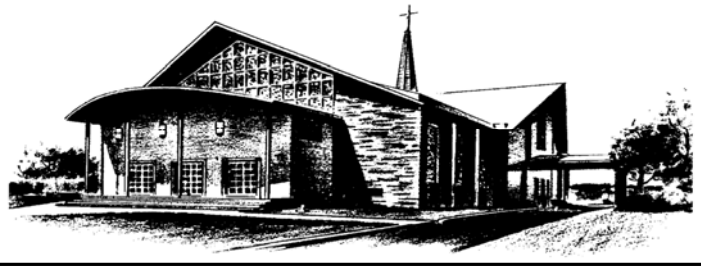

## SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT

### Pastoral Reflection

*"Behold I am the handmaid of the Lord. May it be done to me according to your word." (Lk. 1:38)*

Mary speaks in only two of the four Gospels—twice in Luke in the infancy narrative and twice in John at the Cana miracle. During the month of December, we celebrate two important Marian feasts: the Immaculate Conception on December 8 and Our Lady of Guadalupe on December 12.

The words above that Mary says are a total acceptance of God's will. We could say those words at the beginning of each day. It just takes four seconds. Mary wasn't saying, "This is wonderful. Of course, I'll do it." Instead she is saying, "This isn't what I had planned, and I'm not sure I understand, but I'll do my best to do what the Lord wants." Think about what it means to say words like that at the beginning of everyday. Try it.

Do you think Mary had a sense that she was specially blessed by God? Do you have a sense that God has been specifically at work in you, blessing you with special gifts from your earliest years? After all, God has blessed us with Baptism and Confirmation. He has cleansed us of sin, poured the Holy Spirit into our souls, called each of us by name to be His disciples. Jesus has come to us time and time again at Communion. We have joined with Him and given ourselves to Him when we do His will and give ourselves to Him. These are very special works of God in me.

Each of us, individually, has been, and continues to be, specially blessed by God, just as Mary was. Perhaps it is hard to believe, but we need to believe it and live it, today and every day.

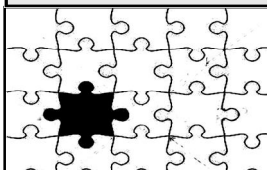

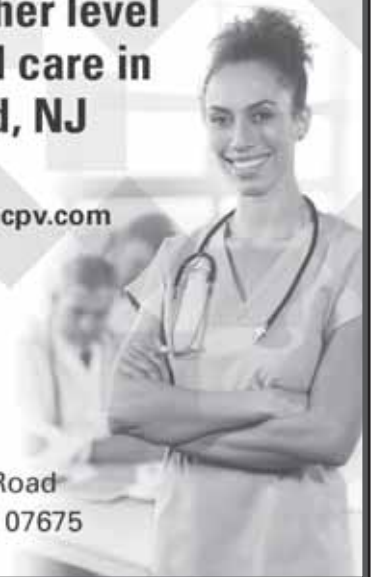
