### Pastor's Letter

Dear Parish Family,

It is with great sadness and regret that I say goodbye today to my beloved friends and parishioners of St. Andrew's Parish. As you know, after I submitted my application for a new assignment, the Cardinal considered my application and I will be serving as the new Pastor of Our Lady of Mount Carmel in Nutley. Wednesday, January 31 is my last official day as your Pastor.

As I write this, my mind is a spinning merry-go-round of vivid images and special memories I have of the last four years and seven months. Life, as you know, is always changing and as one door closes, another one opens to another chapter in our lives. Nothing in this life remains the same; only God is unchanging and constant in His love, at all times.

Big changes in life teach us greater detachment from the things and people of this world and summon us to fix our gaze on the Lord and things eternal. May we not let ourselves get down about such changes. Changes are just part of life.

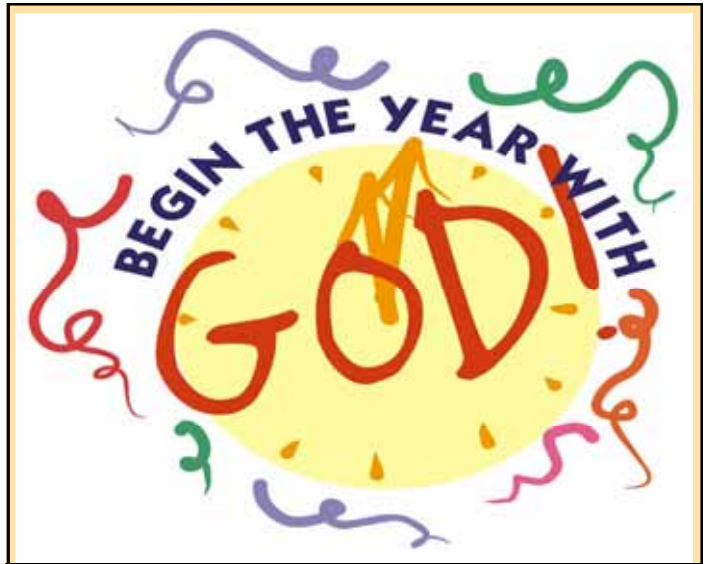
