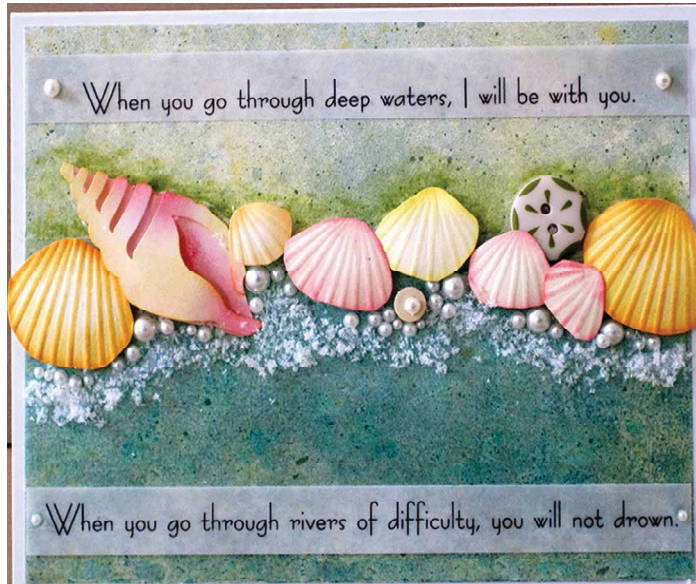
### A Note from Fr. Jim
