ANNOUNCEMENT FROM THE ARCHDIOCESE OF NEWARK

The Archdiocese recently received a request to review an accusation of misconduct with an adult that had been made against Father James Weiner some 15 years ago. The Review Board of the Archdiocese of Newark investigated the accusation against Father Weiner in 2003, even though the case did not involve an allegation of sexual abuse of a minor. On May 20, 2003, the Archdiocese referred the case to the Essex County Prosecutor's Office in accordance with the Memorandum of Understanding among all Catholic dioceses and county prosecutors in the state. The Prosecutor's Office filed no charges. Earlier this month, Cardinal Tobin decided to reopen the case for review out of an abundance of caution at these most difficult times.

While the Archdiocese is undertaking this review of the case, Father Weiner has agreed to voluntarily step aside, even while remaining Pastor of St. Andrew's, until the matter is resolved, out of concern for the people of St. Andrew's parish, for the benefit of the Church, and for his own personal benefit. It is our hope that this will expedite the review and that he would be able to resume his duties.

Even in the short time in which he has been part of the life of St. Andrew's, parishioners have developed a great affection and respect for Father Weiner, and it is with great sadness that he is taking these steps.

We are not in a position to discuss the details of the review of this matter at this time. We hope you will understand and appreciate the need for privacy and discretion as the review takes place. We ask for your understanding and prayers during this time for all victims of abuse, for all clergy, for all members of St. Andrew's Community, and for Father James Weiner.

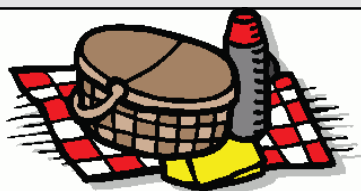
