The Need

Catholic Charities current location was built in 1939 as the original Mowery Clinic and purchased by the Salina Diocese in 1958. Many different services have been provided from this 425 W. Iron location throughout the years. Most notably, the current facility functioned as an orphanage until 1991. As an aged building constructed for different purposes, much of the space has become unworkable for the agency's current services creating significant inefficiencies in daily operations. Lack of sufficient parking and functional storage have also become issues. The tri-level building does not have an elevator making it difficult to navigate for staff, volunteers and clients. The building also suffers from prior water damage, deteriorating plumbing and other structural issues. Careful research revealed that using money for repairs would be wasteful and that the building needed to be demolished and agency services relocated.

The Gift

Two years ago, a donor aware of this need offered to assist Catholic Charities with making a change. With the commitment of this anonymous gift and the *Salina Diocese 2010 Capital Campaign Yesterday, Today and Forever*, the agency purchased another building and began renovations. Throughout this process, there have been a variety of donors and businesses assisting with discounts, in-kind donations and financial gifts (including money raised for the Itemless-Item at the 2016 fundraiser). Each of these contributions has been integral in the completion of this project and enabled the agency to continue using funds raised during its fundraiser and annual appeal for client support services and daily operations. We shall always remember how it all started with *The One Gift*.
