CBS will be offered on Wednesday nights, beginning in September, 6-8 PM at three different sites:

Our Lady of the Snows Parish Center, Reno
St Patrick's, Fallon
St Joseph's Elko

Annual Cost: \$550 per person + books

There will be one Saturday session in Reno, August 25, 9:30-12:30. Our teacher, Gene Giuliano from the University of Dallas, will come to Reno to introduce the program to participants and talk about the Bible from the Catholic perspective. (This session will be taped for registrants who cannot make it that day.)

"This is a four-year program, and participants may attend any or all of the four years. The first two years of the CBS program focus on the biblical books that form the foundation of both the Old and New Testaments. Years Three and Four of the program cover the remaining books of the bible, emphasizing their contexts and principle themes. While starting at the beginning of the four-year cycle is encouraged, a student can join the program at any point."
