Msgr. Michael T. Mannion, STL, MA, is a priest of the Diocese of Camden, New Jersey. He was ordained in St. Peter's Basilica in Rome in 1971. He knew St. Mother Teresa of Calcutta for 29 years and worked with her and her community in Rome, Calcutta, and Washington, D.C. He founded the Discovery Retreat Program in New Jersey in 1974, which led to the authoring of the book "Abortion and Healing, A Cry to be Whole." At present, he is the Chaplain for the FBI (Philadelphia Division) and the New Jersey State Police, and has been an instructor at the Camden County Police Academy for 15 years.

10:00-11:15 3-06 **Gathering the flock when afraid to belong:** the psychological, spiritual, religious and social dynamics and pressures that come into play in a secular world for one who seeks to embrace and proclaim a culture of life

1:00-2:15 4-06 **Pastoral and sacramental reflection** on the loss of life through abortion and violence: communicating a spirit of compassion and conviction in evangelization

2:45-4:00 5-06 **Responding to the stories with love,** in a spirit of civility and love, to those who are wounded is central to the behavior of one who seeks to live and communicate the prolife message. Many who mask their brokenness, which is sometimes exhibited in angry, defensive, and even confrontational reactions, can be reached more holistically through kindness.
