Msgr. Michael T. Mannion, STL, MA, is a priest of the Diocese of Camden, New Jersey. He was ordained in St. Peter's Basilica in Rome in 1971. He knew St. Mother Teresa of Calcutta for 29 years and worked with her and her community in Rome, Calcutta, and Washington, D.C. He founded the Discovery Retreat Program in New Jersey in 1974, which led to the authoring of the book "Abortion and Healing, A Cry to be Whole." At present, he is the Chaplain for the FBI (Philadelphia Division) and the New Jersey State Police, and has been an instructor at the Camden County Police Academy for 15 years.

Christmas Novena Masses

"Simbang Gabi" is a Filipino Christmas tradition consisting of nine dawn masses in preparation for the birth of Jesus Christ. Simbang Gabi used to be celebrated in the early morning. However, over the years, some urban parishes now celebrate the Misa de Gallo (mass of the rooster) in the evening in order to accommodate the needs of the members of the community. Many Catholic Filipino communities around the world practice the Simbang Gabi tradition. No matter how or when this celebration takes place, Simbang Gabi is a strong indication of the depth of Catholicism among the Filipino people. This beautiful celebration will take place in the Diocese of Reno, starting with a Sending Forth Mass at St. Thomas Aquinas Cathedral, presided by Bishop Randolph Calvo, on December 15th at 7:00p.m. The rest of the novena will be celebrated at 7:00p.m. at Immaculate Conception Catholic Church, except on December 21- it will be celebrated at Little Flower Parish at 7:00 pm. Every night a different priest will be the main celebrant. Please join the Filipino Community to celebrate this beautiful Christmas tradition. Everyone is welcome!
