**AT THE ANNUAL DIOCESAN CONFERENCE**

Msgr. Michael T. Mannion, STL, MA, is a priest of the Diocese of Camden, New Jersey. He was ordained in St. Peter's Basilica in Rome in 1971. He knew St. Mother Teresa of Calcutta for 29 years and worked with her and her community in Rome, Calcutta, and Washington, D.C. He founded the Discovery Retreat Program in New Jersey in 1974, which led to the authoring of the book "Abortion and Healing, A Cry to be Whole." At present, he is the Chaplain for the FBI (Philadelphia Division) and the New Jersey State Police, and has been an instructor at the Camden County Police Academy for 15 years.
